

Presidential Award Recognizes U. S. Lighthouse Society

Preserve America is a Presidential initiative that encourages and supports community efforts to preserve and enjoy America's priceless cultural and natural heritage. The goals of the initiative include a greater shared knowledge about the nation's past, strengthened regional identities and local pride, increased local participation in preserving the country's cultural and natural heritage assets, and support for the economic vitality of our communities. Mrs. Laura Bush, the former First Lady of the United States, is the Honorary Chair of Preserve America.

In 2004, the United States Lighthouse Society entered into a 90-year lease for the Thomas Point Shoal Lighthouse, a National Historic Landmark that is located about 1-1/2 miles offshore in the Chesapeake Bay. Since then, volunteers of our Chesapeake Chapter have done everything from window restoration to lead paint abatement and much more as part of building rehabilitation. Volunteers also conduct research and serve as docents for public tours.
